### 1. Our Bank Commits UGX 500M to this year's Rotary Cancer Run

To accelerate the fight against cancer, our Bank shall contribute UGX 500 million toward this year's mission, bringing hope and life-saving care to families across Uganda. Our Executive Director, Joseph Balikuddembe, joined the Guest of Honor, Rt. Hon. Anita Among, Speaker of Parliament, and PDG Steven Mwanje, and other distinguished guests, to champion to champion this vital cause.

### 2. Our Bank collaborates with the Rotary Club of Kyadondo in a tree-growing initiative.



On 21<sup>st</sup> November 2025, Our Bank entered a collaborative tree-growing initiative with the Rotary Club of Kyadondo. Through this partnership, 4,000 indigenous trees are to be planted in Miti Village, Mukono District, advancing our commitment to promote environmental sustainability and strengthen community resilience. To support this initiative, the Bank committed UGX 12,000,000 for the next six months. This forms part of our long-term ambition to grow over 500,000 trees in the next five years.

Centenary Group, comprising of Centenary Bank, Centenary Technology Services, and the Centenary Foundation has set a target of planting 1.9 million trees, underscoring our sustained investment in a greener and more sustainable future.
